Measures 1-8 of the violin part. The music is in 2/4 time, B-flat major, and begins with a forte (*f*) dynamic. The melody is characterized by eighth-note patterns and dotted rhythms.

Measures 9-16. Measure 9 starts with a mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamic. The piece features a melodic line in the right hand and a supporting bass line in the left hand. Dynamics range from *mf* to *f*.

Measures 17-26, marked with a box 'A'. Measure 17 begins with a mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamic. The texture is primarily chordal, with a strong bass line. Dynamics include *mf* and *f*.

Measures 27-35. Measure 27 starts with a piano (*p*) dynamic. The music becomes more rhythmic and includes accents. Dynamics range from *p* to *sf* (sforzando).

Measures 36-44. Measure 36 is marked 'unis.' (unisono). Measure 37 is marked 'divisi'. Measure 44 ends with a mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamic. The piece concludes with a final chord.






